BARRA OF MENDOCINO

From the far away hills of Piedmont, Italy to the inviting landscapes of Northern California, the legacy of fine organic grape-growing techniques continues on in each bottle of BARRA of Mendocino wine.

As you take a walk through the vineyard with Charlie Barra, you'll find yourself surrounded by 60 year old, craggy, grapevines that resemble the sun-baked hands of the farmer that has nurtured them. These hearty, twisted vines, located on the bench lands at the headwaters of the Russian River in Redwood Valley, California, are the source of the superior organic fruit that goes into each bottle of BARRA of Mendocino wines.

Following in the footsteps of his father, Antonio Barra, and his maternal grandfather, Guiseppe Rovera (who immigrated to Mendocino County from Piedmont, Italy in 1906), Charlie began farming grapes in the mid 1940's. By 1954 he had purchased Redwood Valley Vineyards, the ranch that is home to over 175 acres of organically grown Pinot Noir, Zinfandel, Cabernet Sauvignon, Sangiovese, Merlot, Petite Sirah, Chardonnay, Pinot Blanc, Pinot Grigio and Muscat Canelli. In 1955, when Charlie began planting new vines, he was fortunate to be able to rely on the practical experience of his father

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and grandfather to help him make the right choice in selecting rootstock and varietal clones.

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These choices, over the years, have proven that he made the right ones. “Why wouldn’t I farm organically”, states Charlie Barra. “Yes, it’s more work (annual audits/certifications, paperwork, labor requirements), more risk (crop devastation from pests) and not necessarily a bigger payout, but it’s essential to the well-being of this planet”, says Barra. “We need to leave this earth the way we found it, and this doesn’t include chemicals”.

The Barra vineyards have been certified by the CCOF (California Certified Organic Farmers) for over 20 years now (and it had taken another three years of inspections prior to that for the certification to become complete). But Charlie’s favorite saying is “I’ve really been farming organically for 55 years...I just didn’t know it the first 30!” Prior to World War II, growing without commercial chemicals and fertilizers was standard procedure.

With over 6 decades of experience in the back pocket of his Wrangler jeans, Charlie Barra, now 87 years old, farms his organic vineyards with the goal of producing rich, distinguishable fruits that “shine through” in every glass of BARRA of Mendocino. www.barraofmendocino.com

BRUTOCAO CELLARS

Winemaking traditions often begin around the table. Brutocao Cellars’ roots started four generations ago, around a dinner table in Venice, Italy. When the Brutocao family came to the New World and married into the Bliss family of farmers, it was only natural that they would combine their passions and become grape growers and winemakers.

Irv Bliss purchased his Mendocino County property in 1943. The Brutocao family released their first vintage in 1980. Shortly after, they chose the Lion of St. Mark, modeled after the lion on top of St. Mark’s Cathedral in Venice, Italy, as their symbol of family tradition and quality. That quality comes from the location of their 400 acres of vineyards in southern Mendocino County.

The Brutocao family tradition of serving wine at a table means wines are produced with good food and good friends in mind. Today, the family still blends their Italian heritage with their rural agricultural lifestyle to make some of California’s finest wines – producing 30 wines from 15 varietals of grapes grown in Southern Mendocino County and Anderson Valley. These wines include Zinfandel, Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Pinot Noir, Chardonnay and

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Sauvignon Blanc, as well as Italian varietals such as Primitivo, Barbera, Sangiovese, Dolcetto, and the proprietary Quadriga, a blend of all four of their Italian varietals.

Since our founding in 1968 in beautiful Mendocino County, Fetzer Vineyards has been a pioneer of California winemaking. 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GOLDEN VINEYARDS

Julie Golden was born in Mendocino County and raised in an old farmhouse overlooking her family's vineyard. The view from the Mattern family's kitchen window looked out upon rows of vines leading to the hills beyond. As her career took her around the world she always felt the tug of that view.

Joe Golden has always loved wine. As an undergraduate at Stanford he began a wine club. In between high tech start-ups and world travel, he made weekend treks up from Silicon Valley to the wine country. There he explored the surrounding vineyards and learned the ins and outs of the business from winemakers.

Joe and Julie met in Germany where they both worked in the high tech field. When it came time to raise a family they began their search for a healthy, beautiful place to grow their family. To Julie, that meant having vineyards of her own in Mendocino County. To Joe, vineyards meant making his own wine.

The Goldens discovered Heart Arrow Ranch in 1997 located on the edge of Redwood Valley. Heart Arrow is a striking mountain ridge perfectly suited to growing world-class grapes. It was a perfect site for Joe to plant the Cabernet Sauvignon vineyard he had always dreamed of.

From the start Julie's childhood friend, the late Bobby Fetzer, urged the Goldens to farm Biodynamically. In Biodynamic farming, all activities are designed to increase biodiversity, restore the integrity of the soil and enhance the quality and health of the fruit. To do so they had to find the right vineyard manager. They found their man in Jerry Yates. Jerry was renowned for converting 1,200 acres of Mendocino County vineyards to organic farming in the 1980's and pioneering Biodynamic farming in the vineyard with Bobby Fetzer.

Heart Arrow Ranch is a fully functional farm with over 7 acres of olive trees, fruit orchard, vegetable garden and pastures full of chickens, sheep, pigs, and cattle. The Goldens partnered with Adam and Paula Gaska of Mendocino Organics who manage the onsite produce garden and farm animals.

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MCFADDEN FARMS

Located in Potter Valley, McFadden Vineyard, has been family owned and operated since 1970, where Guinness McFadden has been farming organically for over 40 years. The hot days and cool nights of Potter Valley give McFadden wines exceptional character and flavor; and meticulous care of the soil enables them to produce top quality grapes year after year.

A vibrant natural ecosystem, which is essential to maintaining a healthy organic vineyard, is supported by the renowned Russian River and neighboring Mendocino National Forest. Thankfully, not much has changed in pastoral Potter Valley in the past 50 years...it is truly a hidden gem.

McFadden began producing wine in 2003 after many years selling grapes to top wineries in the Napa, Sonoma, and Mendocino counties. Its first wine label was a pinot gris in which 300 cases were produced and sold quickly. The following year it produced a Riesling and in 2005 sauvignon blanc, pinot noir, and zinfandel. In 2006, chardonnay was introduced to the McFadden collection of wines.

From the very beginning McFadden Vineyard has been organic and has been certified as such by the California Certified Organic Farmers (CCOF). McFadden wines state on the label, "made from organically grown grapes." This is an assurance that at no time were any chemical fertilizers or pesticides ever used in the production of the grapes in our wines.

The boutique winery makes fewer than 3,000 cases of wine per year and continues to showcase the quality of grapes they've grown for the past 40 years with every vintage.

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TESTA VINEYARDS

Testa Vineyards was established in 1912 by Gaetano and Maria Testa. Gaetano left his homeland of Gallarate, Italy to come to America following his dream to own vineyard land.

After working in San Francisco a few years, he then traveled north by train. At the first sight of Calpella it reminded him of his homeland, full of beautiful hillsides and lush trees, he knew this was the land to buy. He then sent for his wife Maria and son Victor Testa. The whole family worked side by side to clear the land using Belgian horses and dynamite sticks. They planted their first vines and the story began.

The varietals planted on the Testa Ranch are Carignane, Petite Sirah, Zinfandel, Barbera, Grenache and Charbono. Also just to the north is our Gusto Vineyards – Hillside Cabernet Sauvignon. The Testa family is able to make the best “Black” wine using their own fruit. They take great pride in the way they farm their land and vines. It shows in the fruit they harvest.

The Testa ranch is full of memories and stories of all the hard work and challenges that their family has faced throughout the years... but mostly of the good times spent together, making great wine and life-long friends.
